Principles (GDPR Article 5)

Principle	How we satisfy it
Lawfulness, fairness, transparency (Art. 5(1)(a))	Lawful basis: contract performance (Art. 6(1)(b)); legitimate interest for security (Art. 6(1)(f)). Privacy policy and DPA published.
Purpose limitation (Art. 5(1)(b))	Data used only to operate Olyteck Cyber for the customer. Never sold; never used to train AI models.
Data minimisation (Art. 5(1)(c))	We process metadata only - never file contents or e-mail bodies. Detailed evidence stays in the customer's browser.
Accuracy (Art. 5(1)(d))	Configuration is read directly from Microsoft Graph on each scan. Stale data is overwritten on re-scan.
Storage limitation (Art. 5(1)(e))	Documented retention windows - findings 180 days default; logs 90 days; deletion within 30 days of termination.
Integrity and confidentiality (Art. 5(1)(f))	TLS in transit; AES-256 at rest; least-privilege access; documented incident response.
Accountability (Art. 5(2))	InfoSec Policy, S-SDLC, risk register, audit log, documented controls - available to customers.

Data-subject rights (Articles 12-22)

Olyteck assists the customer (as controller) in responding to data-subject rights requests covering access, rectification, erasure, restriction, portability, and objection. The product surfaces the relevant data points; the customer issues the response. Operational support is provided through support@olyteck.com.

International transfers (Chapter V)

Application data and backups stay in the European Union. Where a sub-processor operates outside the European Economic Area, transfers are governed by Standard Contractual Clauses (Decision 2021/914) and, where applicable, the EU-US Data Privacy Framework, supported by encryption and access control.

Breach notification (Article 33)

Olyteck operates a documented incident-response process and notifies affected customers of personal-data incidents without undue delay and within 72 hours of confirmation.

Records of processing (Article 30)

Olyteck maintains a record of processing activities covering categories of personal data, categories of recipients, retention periods, and applicable safeguards. An excerpt is available to customers on request.

Sub-processors (Article 28)

Each sub-processor is bound by a written agreement imposing GDPR-equivalent obligations. The current list is published at cyber.olyteck.com/trust and customers are notified 30 days in advance of any material change.
